




VERIFYING THE FOUR COLOUR THEOREM

Proofs of mathematical theorems that require large computer calculations are still controversial: It is thought that computer programs cannot be reviewed with mathematical rigour. In this talk, Georges Gonthier will overturn this belief by reviewing his fully computer-checked proof of the famous Four Colour Theorem.
